INTRODUCTION

The Muslim Youth Movement of South Africa is an organisation that was founded and based on the ideology of Islam as embodied in the Holy Quraan as well as the teachings and sunnah of our beloved Prophet Muhammed (SAW). It is this ideology alone which guides, binds, moves and motivates us to strive for equality, justice, excellence, peace and harmony within our diverse community. This incentive also unites us as a single committed fraternity irrespective of race, colour, class or nationality in order to pursue our common goals and aims.

The MYM began on the 16th of December 1970 in Durban in response to the call of the Quraan:

“Let there arise out of you a band of people inviting to all that is good, enjoying what is right, forbidding what is evil: they are the ones to attain success... '85..”

The MYM soon developed into a National organisation with youth throughout the country rallying to the call to struggle for the realisation of Islam as a comprehensive way of life.

Since the inception of the MYM (1970) there were 3 regions in which we had organised structures: Natal; Western Cape and Gauteng. In March 1990 the membership of the MYM decided to accept two more regions into the organisation: Eastern Cape and Free State, thereby spreading its activities to all corners of South Africa.

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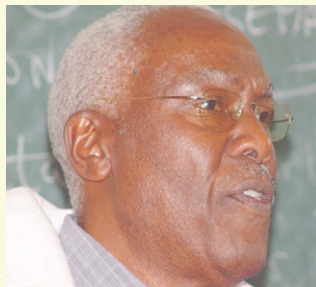

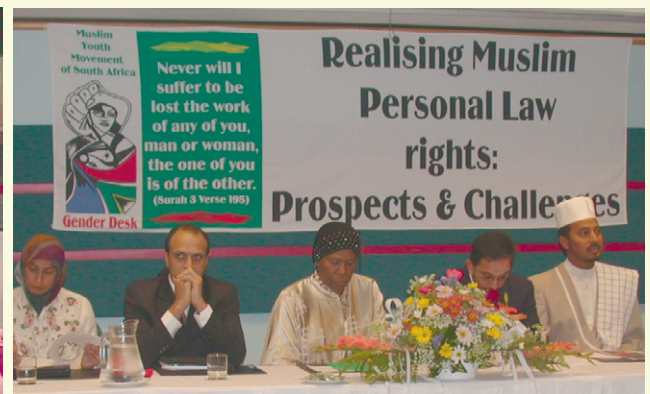
